I am requesting funding for the Huntington Townwide Repavement Project in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of Huntington, located at 100 Main Street, Huntington, NY 11743.

The funding would be used for a paving project that directly targets areas that are in dire need of resurfacing. These roads are all throughout the township including areas with a lot of economic development. This repaving project would cover nearly 25 miles of road.
